## **IDEARESTYLE**Cleaning Guide





The different wash cycles listed below do not replace the need to disassemble the components for regular sanitization.

#### ACCESSING THE PROGRAMMING MENU

Press the Menu button on the control panel.

Enter password by pressing the UP or DOWN buttons to select a number.

Press OK to select the menu option required to perform the maintenance.



#### PERFORMING A WASH CYCLE

#### **BREW GROUP WASH**

- In the Programming Menu, select the "Maintenance" option, then the GROUP RINSING submenu. (The GROUP RINSING submenu can also be accessed by selecting Washing Menu under the "Technical" option.)
- Press on the OK button (screen will display "PUT THE TABLET INTO THE GROUP".)
- 3 Remove the brew group (screen will display "INS. BREW GROUP".) (Fig. 1)
- 4 Insert a brew group cleaning tablet into the brew group.



Use only coffee machine-specific products.
Follow the dosing directions on the product packaging.

Reinstall the brew group (screen will display "CLOSE SERV. DOOR"), then close the door. (Fig. 2)

The machine will automatically start performing a wash cycle. Screen will display "REMOVE THE GROUP AND RINSE IT WITH WATER" when wash cycle is completed.

- 6 Remove the brewer group (screen will display "INS. BREW GROUP".) (Fig. 1)
- 7 Wash the brew group under running water.
- 8 Reinstall the brew group (screen will display "CLOSE SERV. DOOR"), then close the door. (Fig. 2)
- 9 When screen displays "RINSING COMPLETED PRESS OK", press the OK button.
- 10 Remove and empty the drip tray, then reinstall it. Do not drink this water.





#### CLEANING MILK COMPONENTS

#### COFFEE DISPENSING SPOUT & CAPPUCCINATORE

- Remove the upper protection cover by pulling it outwards.
- Remove the fork and the crema adjusting lever.
- 3 Unscrew the lower knob to remove the lower protection cover.
- 4 Remove the fitting connecting the milk tube to the Cappuccinatore connector, then remove the milk dispensing spout and the milk tube.
- Remove the Cappuccinatore casing and the Cappuccinatore body cap.
- 6 Remove the temperature adjusting lever.
- Remove the coffee dispensing spout by pulling it outwards and dismantle it.
- 8 Wash all parts in cleaning solution using a small brush.



Use only milk system and coffee machine-specific products. Follow the dosing directions on the product packaging.

1 Immerse the milk tube into a container with water and press on the Milk button. (Fig. 1)



Do not use hot water.

- 2 During the cleaning cycle process, clean the cooling unit with a soft cloth. (Fig. 2)
- 3 At the end of the cycle, remove and empty the container. Do not drink this water.
- 4 Replace the milk tube inside cooling unit.



Make sure the milk tube is correctly positioned so it is supplied with milk.
